On Tuesday December 5<sup>th</sup>, Youth Empowered in the struggle (Voces de la Frontera's youth branch), will be traveling to Washington, D.C. to take part in a national day of action for a **CLEAN** Dream Act.

The National Day of Action (December 6th, 2017) will be a day to call on Congress and Speaker Paul Ryan (Representative of Wisconsin's 1st district) to pass a Clean Dream Act that does not include funding for a lethal wall along the Mexican-US border, any funds for immigration detention centers and/or more ICE border agents. The Dream Act would allow students to continue their education and live in this country without fear of being deported.
