In response to your non-formal complaint of safety and/or health hazards, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has notified Echo Lakes Food, Inc., requesting that appropriate action be taken to correct the situation. Enclosed is a copy of that letter for your information. As the letter indicates, the employer has been given five (5) business days to correct the hazards. Please notify me if no correction has been made within five (5) business days. We have not revealed your identity to the employer. When we receive additional information from the employer, we will notify you of the response.

Section 11(c) of the OSH Act provides protection for employees against discrimination because of their involvement in protected safety and health related activity. If you believe you are being treated differently or action is being taken against you because of your safety or health activity, you may file a complaint with OSHA. You should file this complaint as soon as possible since OSHA normally can accept only those complaints filed within 30 days of the alleged discriminatory action.
